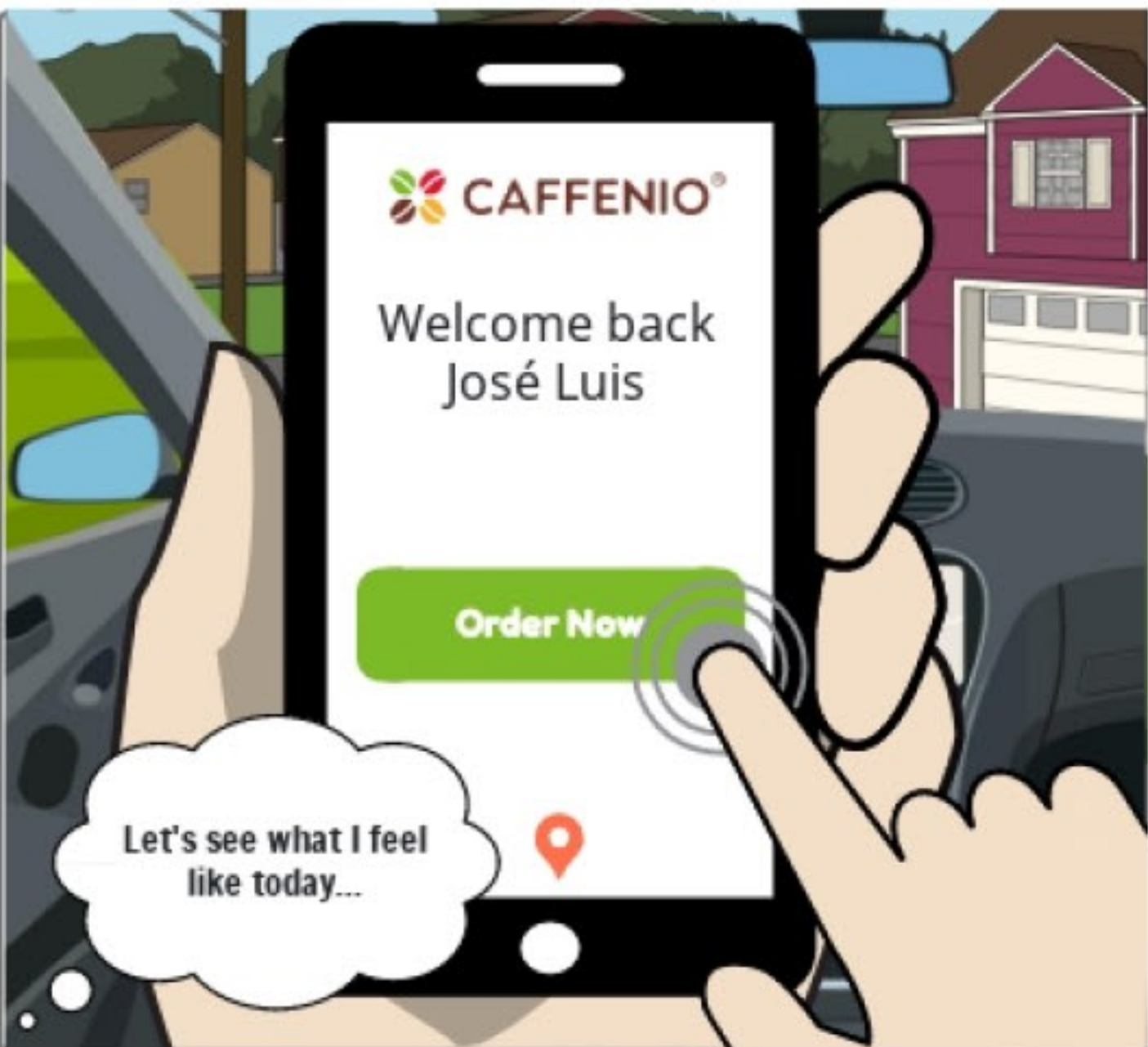




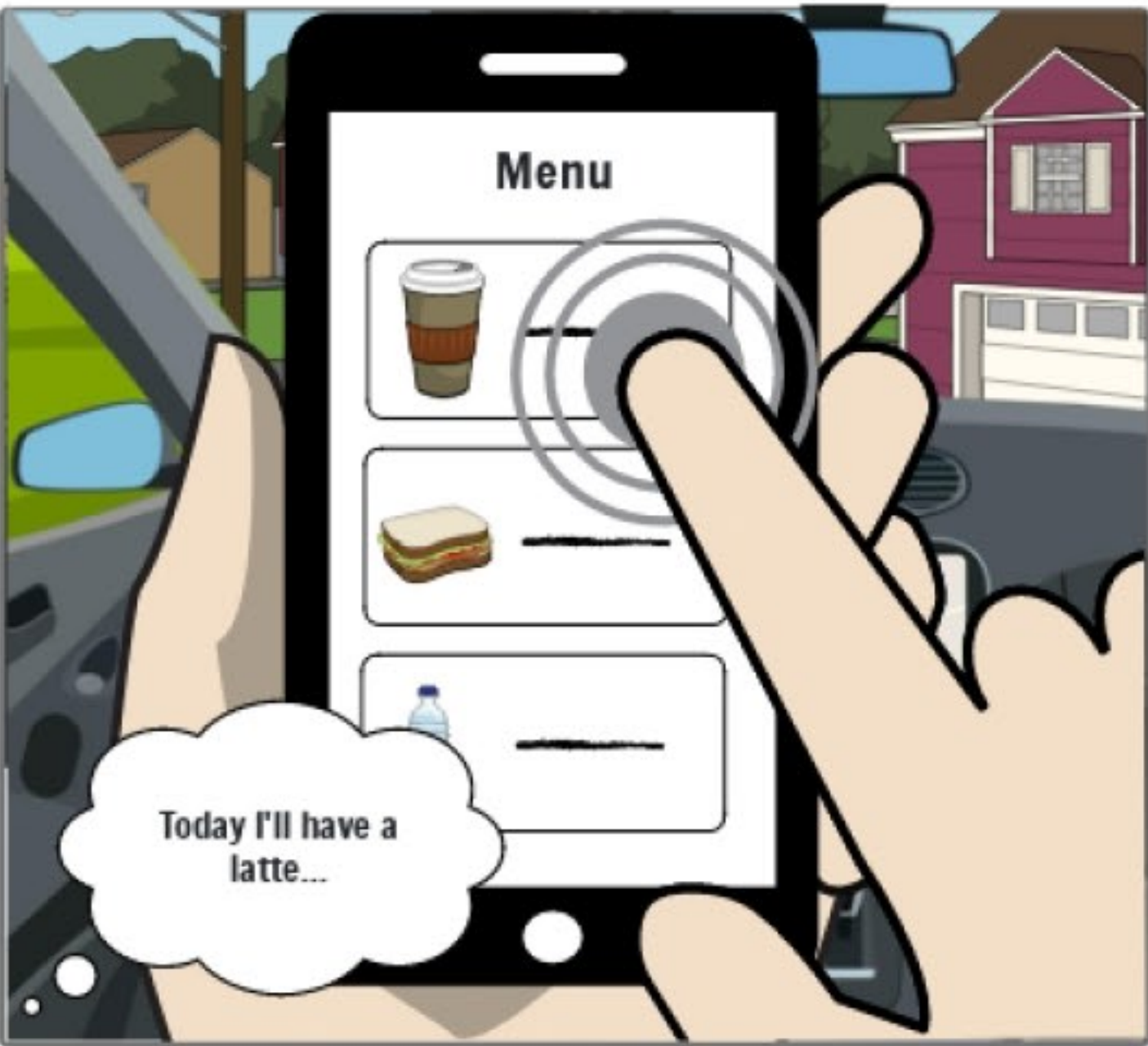
José Luis just checked traffic before leaving his apartment, leaving him with a 15-minute window to place an order for picking up a coffee and breakfast from Caffenio.



He gets into his car, starts it and makes sure he has enough gas to get to work. He grabs his phone and starts placing an online order after making sure everything is alright.



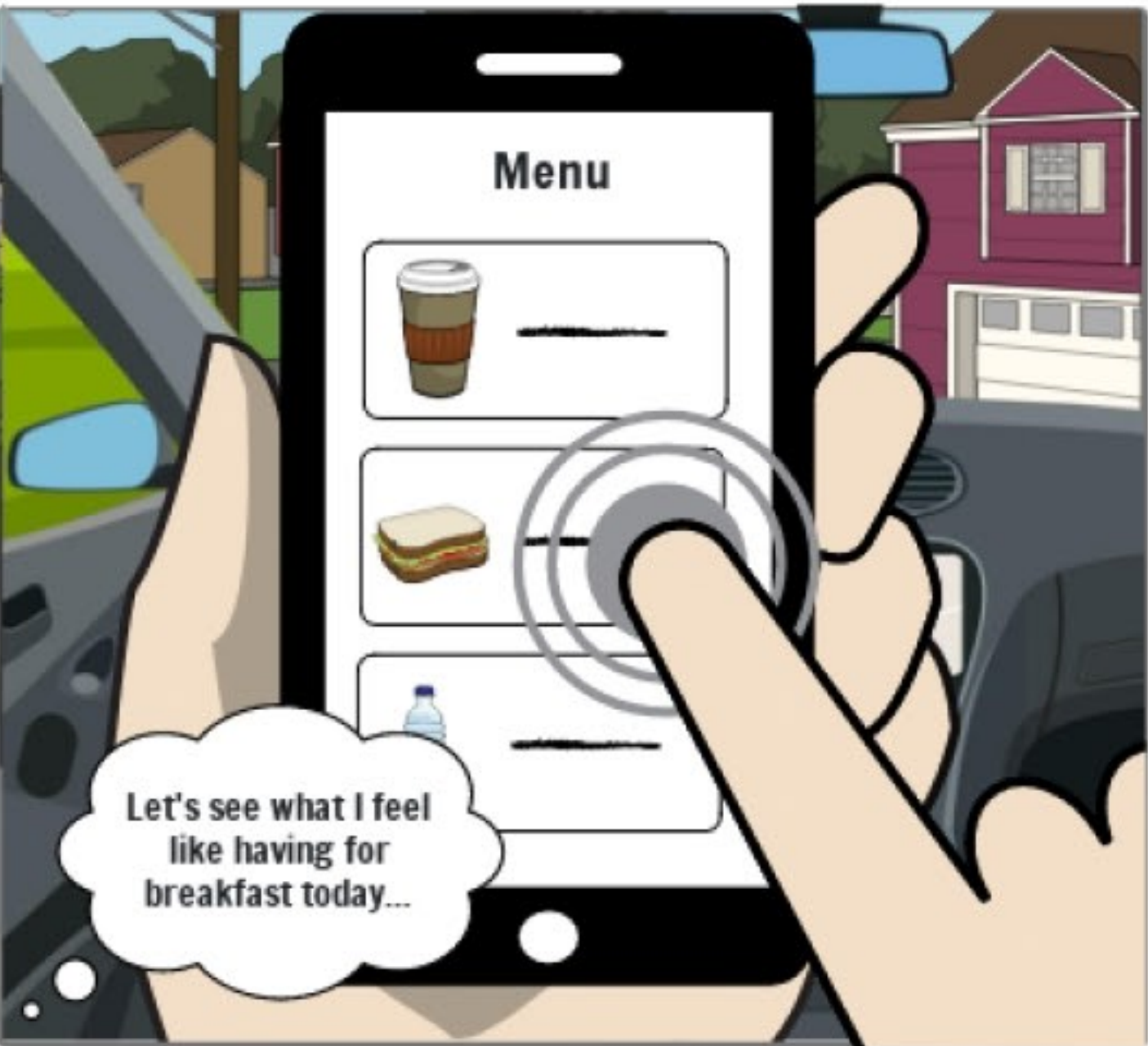
José Luis opens the Caffenio app and taps the Order Now button on the homescreen.



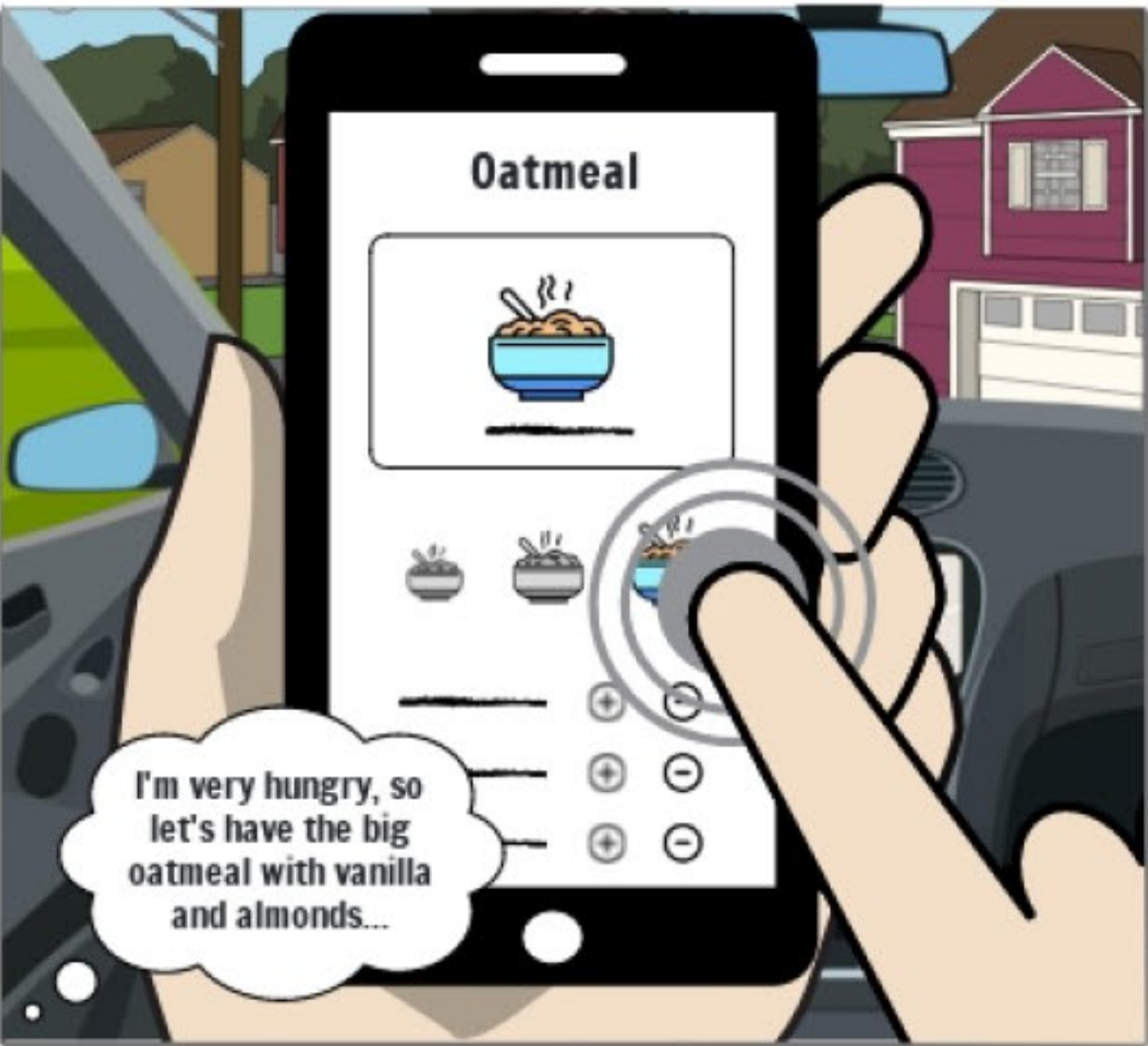
He explores the menu and decides to add a latte.



José Luis customizes his latte, adds it to the order because he's also thinking of ordering something for breakfast.



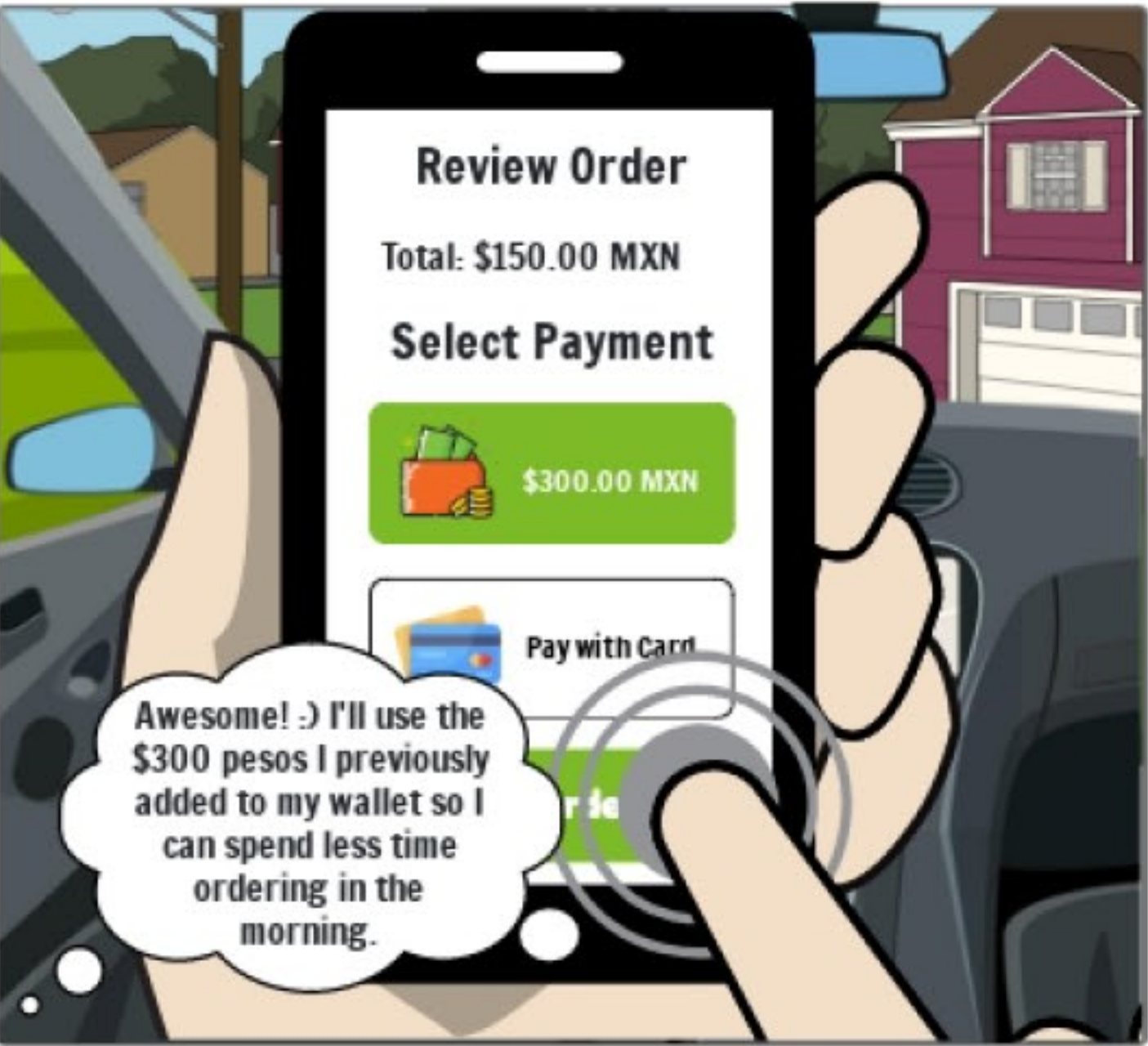
He goes to the food section and explores the available items they currently have at the selected Caffenio location.



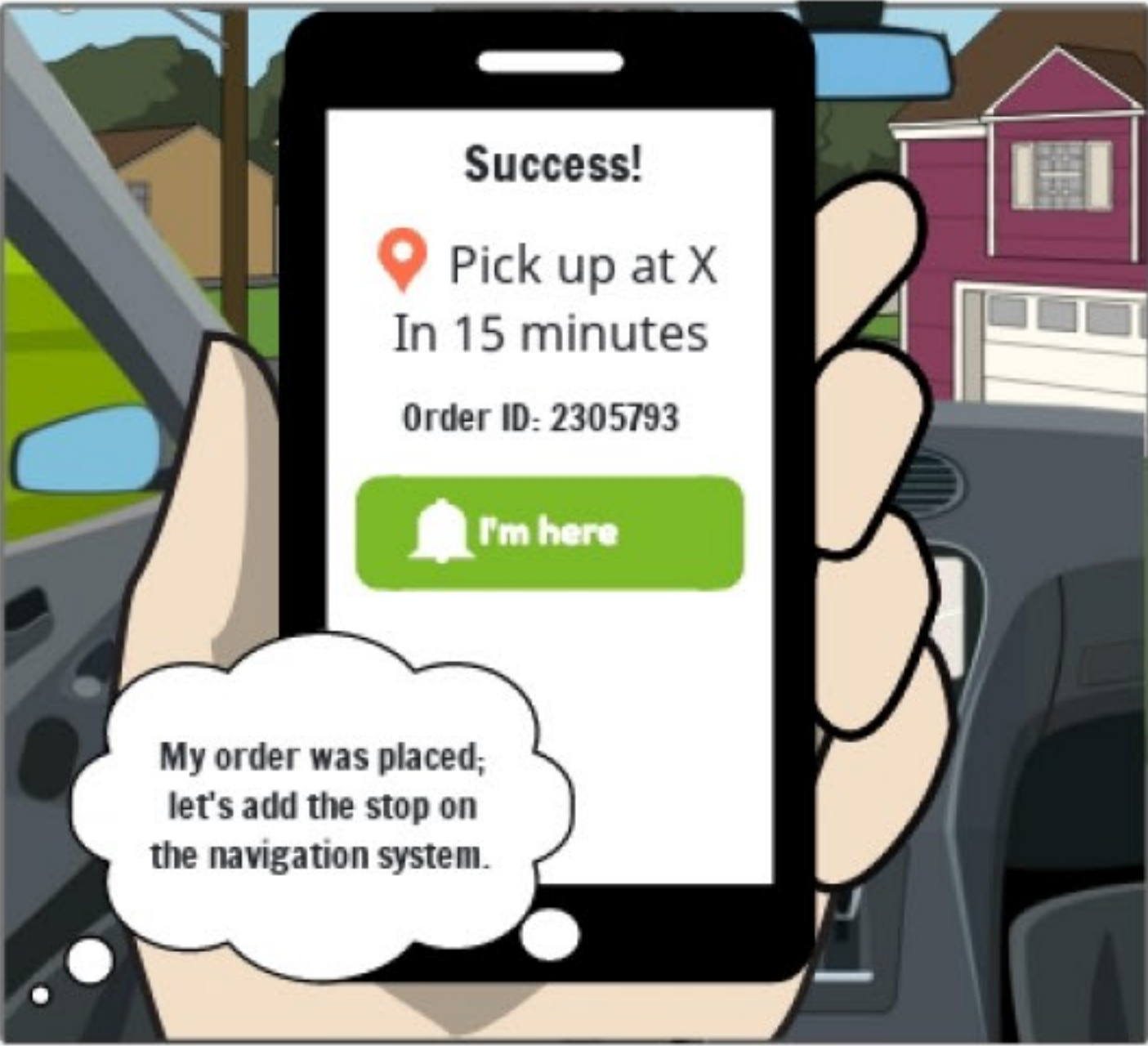
He customizes the oatmeal and taps Proceed to checkout to pay for his full order.



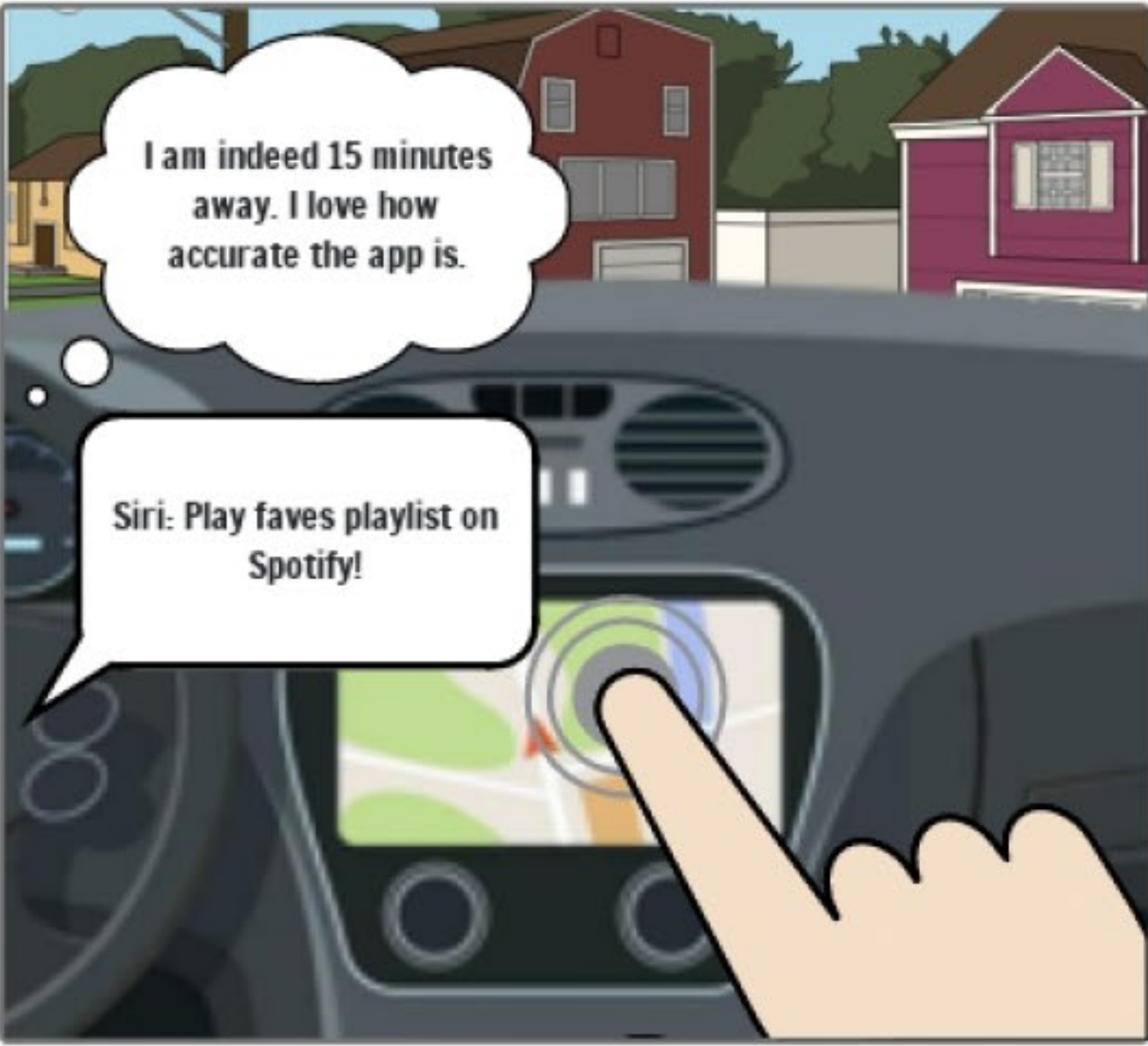
José Luis decides not to change the pickup time the app is suggesting since the app can determine how far away he is from the location.

José Luis receives confirmation that his order was successfully placed and adds the stop to his navigation system.



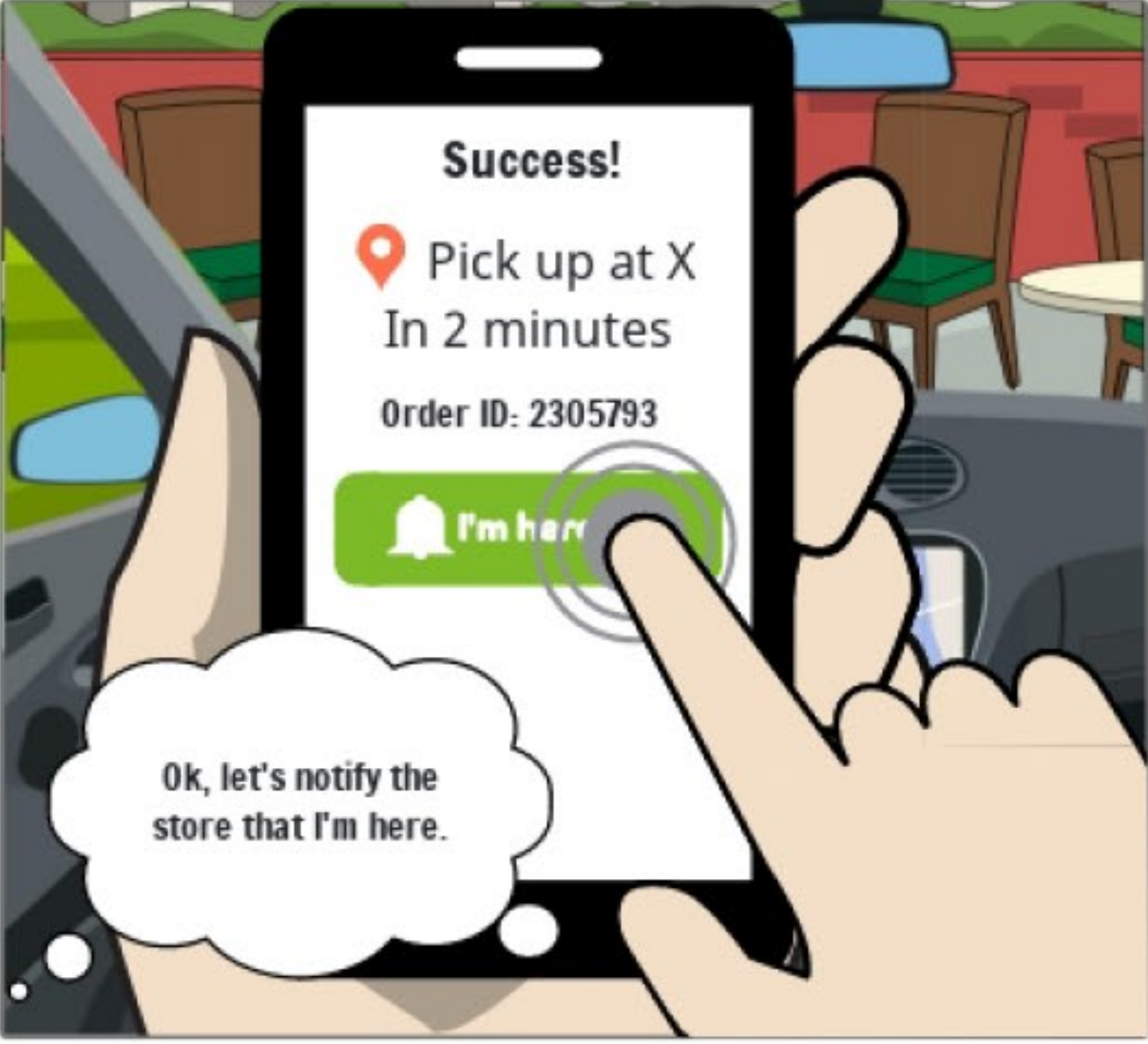
He confirms he is 15 minutes away from the Caffenio location and starts driving.



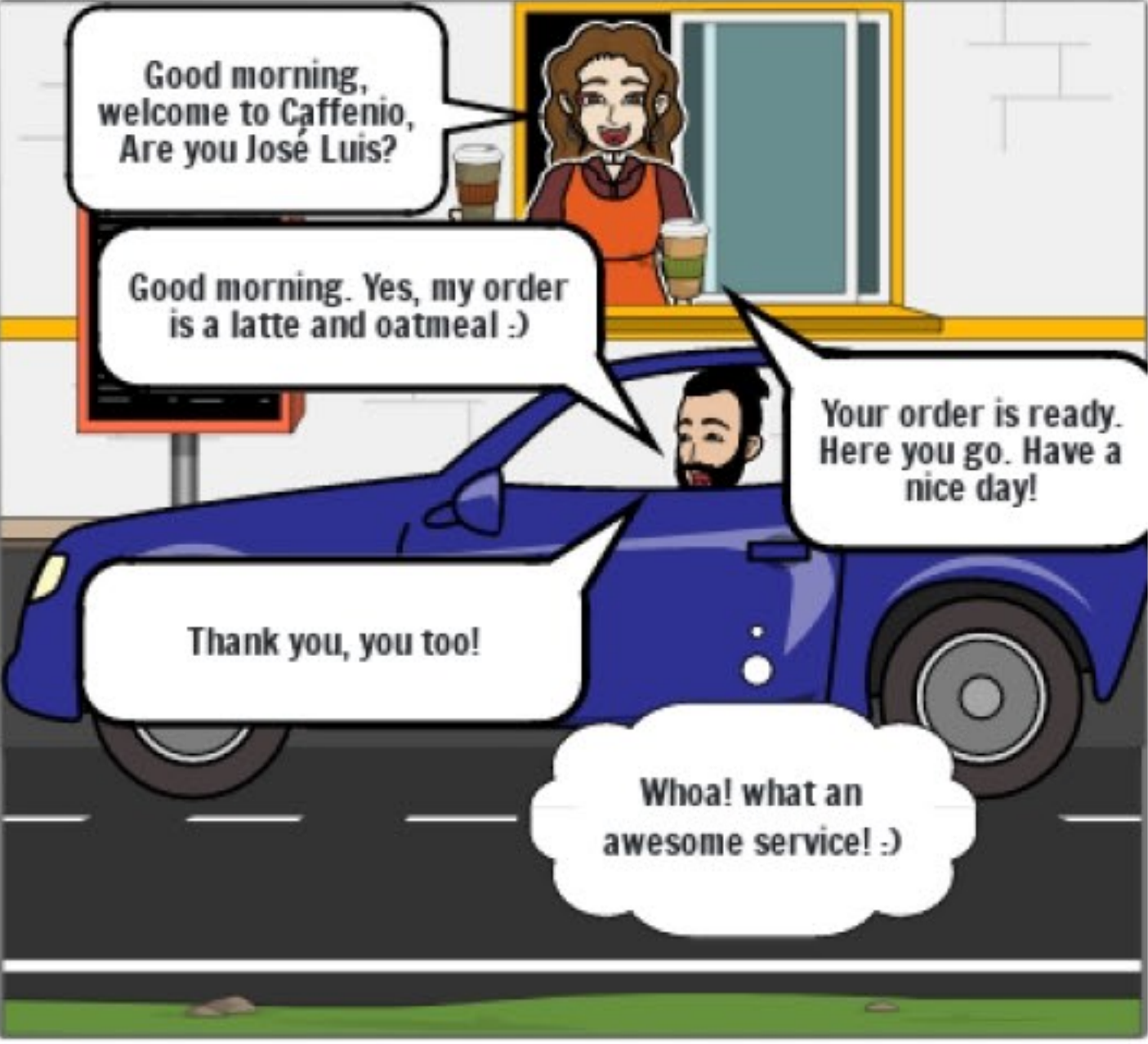
He starts his morning commute to work. He's happy because he will be able to have a nice cup of coffee and breakfast today.
